When anyone sells a property, the exemptions stay on until December 31st of that year.



Illinois pays their tax bills **ONE YEAR BEHIND.** In 2021, you are paying 2020's tax bill.

Mr. Jones, who is 69 years old, sells you his home on 3/14/2021.



Spring Shred Day

South Rock Island Township will partner with Arc Industries to offer a free SHRED DAY for the residents of our Township. The shredding event will take place on April 28, 2021 from 9:30 to 11:30 am at the Township Office— 4330 11th St. RI. Each resident is allowed to bring up to 75 lbs. per person. Last year we shredded over 1,368 pounds of paper. Please note that documents will be places in locked bins and then moved to a secure, surveillanced area at the Arc of the QC, to be shredded. IS YOUR HOME SAFE FROM LEAD -BASED PAINT?

Do you live in an older home that may have peeling paint or old windows? We can help make repairs to your home to make it lead (base paint) safe for your family.

Lead poisoning is a leading environmental illness of children and is caused primarily by lead-based paint in older homes. Although, substantial progress has been made in recent years, the State of Illinois maintains one of the highest rates in the nation for the number of children with elevated blood lead levels (EBLL's). Most recently, the State of Illinois reduced the EBLL threshold from 10 $\mu g/dL$ to 5 $\mu g/dL$. The most common exposure to lead for children is through the ingestion of paint chips and contaminated dust from deteriorated or disturbed lead-based paint in homes built before 1978.

The City of Moline is the Responsible Entity (RE) who will serve as the central location (department) for this Illinois Quad Cities \$2,400,000 Lead Based Paint Hazard Reduction Grant Program and will be responsible for ensuring program compliance among the Illinois Quad Cities Healthy Homes Coalition (Coalition). The Coalition members carrying out the objectives in this new lead grant opportunity include: four local neighboring governments: City of Moline, City of Silvis, City of East Moline and the City of Rock Island; one Community Housing Development Organization, Project NOW, and the Rock Island County Health Department.



If you or someone you know needs a coat please feel free to stop in anytime during business hours and someone will come help you pick out a coat!








Spring Leaf Bags

Beginning April 5th, residents may pick up free leaf bags at South Rock Island Township - 4330 11th St (can use either door). The Township hours are 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. & 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. A daily maximum of 20 bags, with a Rock Island ID, will be provided to each resi-





Curbside pickup of leaf bags will be April 12th – April 30th. Please be aware that leaf bags will only be picked up on your regular garbage pickup day. Yard waste stickers are not necessary during this time, due to this being a free program through the City of Rock Island.





General Township Programs





General Assistance- Monthly



This program provides a basic needs allowance. All applicants must meet state mandated guidelines, and participate in the township's community work program or employment job search program.



Emergency Assistance



Once in a 12-month period, families with children, may receive aid to alleviate life threatening circumstances or to assist in attaining self sufficiency. Residents **must** produce a Late Notice.

For General and Emergency Assistance: All individuals and families **must** come to the township to fill out a checklist and application, to see if they qualify.



Employment Assistance



Newly hired residents may qualify to receive job related supplies to begin their jobs. Applicants must provide proof of hire, ID, and the supplies required by the employer (i.e. uniform, steel toe boots, state ID/driver's license, etc.).



Unemployment Bus Tickets (yearly)



An unemployed resident may receive 20 free bus tickets in a 12-month period. An ID and current piece of mail **dated** within the last 30 days for proof of residency is required to obtain tickets. *Junk mail and medical cards will not be accepted as a valid piece of mail.*



Temporary Handicapped Placards



The placard offers parking privileges for those with temporary disabilities. Doctor's forms and placards are available at the Township. If you wish to obtain a permanent handicapped placard or license plate, you must mail your application to Springfield.



Senior Food & Denture Program— 62 & older!



If you're a South Rock Island resident, are 62 or older, and income qualify, you may participate in our Senior Food or Denture Program. Seniors with a maximum income of \$1,600 per month (\$19,200 yearly) for one person, or a maximum of \$2,000 (\$24,000 yearly) for a two-person household are eligible to apply. Those that meet all requirements could receive a \$25 monthly gift certificate to Hy-Vee. Under the same eligibility requirements, the Township has a program for seniors to receive new or replacement dentures. *Individuals must not have dental insurance to apply*

To apply you must submit the following:

- Current piece of mail dated within the last 30 days (**no** junk mail)
- Current driver's license or state ID card showing residence in our Township
- Current Social Security statement
- Current bank statement
- Any other income from pensions or retirements, employment, or rental properties
- Last years tax return

No appointment necessary. Come to the Township with your information, fill out a short application, and see if you qualify! For list of pick up and program dates, please visit or call the Township Office!
